Bridgeport Community Centre Dances 1974 to 1976 (a print version)

There was a sequence of locations where dances had been held in 1972 and 1973: **Hammarskjold House**, **Jason's**, **Oddfellows Hall** (Lodge St.), University of Waterloo (**Campus Centre**) and finally the **Oddfellows Hall** again.

But in 1974 the **Oddfellows Hall** was no longer available to **WUGLM**. The **Faces** partnership was then formed and organized a long series of dances at the Bridgeport Community Centre in Bridgeport and sold this service to WUGLM. The Faces group was comprised of **Murray** **** (who handled the music, as the DJ), **Bryan** **** (the bar manager), **Barry** **** (who handled admission and food), and **Dennis Findlay** (who was involved in some capacity until **Gracey's** started up; he moved to Toronto on 1975, August 5, where he became a prominent gay activist). Faces also handled **Gracey's** in 1976.

The Bridgeport Community Centre dances drew people from all over Southern Ontario, Toronto, Hamilton, London, St. Catherines, and Guelph. Once the Bridgeport dances went to a strict two-week schedule all other groups scheduled around the Bridgeport dances.

Here is the sequence (note that there are some numbering anomalies) up to 1976, Aug.27 (the dances continued on for several more years, but we do not have the dates when they occurred):
