

Feldstein in Waterloo. She sings regularly with Arcady, and has participated in the Boris Brott Music Festival with the National Academy Orchestra. She has performed many times in the Cambridge "Mayor's Celebration of the Arts", one year presenting a half hour set of "Vocal Music by Cambridge Composers", including beginner composition students as young as ten years old. She occasionally sings with the Cambridge Community Orchestra, and is a chorus member with Opera Hamilton. Annetta has worked with Galt Little Theatre, has conducted the Gilbert and Sullivan Ensemble of Kitchener-Waterloo and the Cambridge Portuguese Banda Lira do Espirito Santo. She currently works with the Cambridge Kiwanis Boys Choir. She is organist and music director at St. James' Anglican church where she leads an adult choir and a youth choir. She has accomplished grade 10 voice, grade 9 piano, grade 8 violin, and grade 2 theory, with the Royal Conservatory of Music. In 2011, Annetta was one of the finalists nominated for a Bernice Adams Memorial Award, which is presented to artists making a difference in their community. She currently lives in Cambridge and teaches privately. She spends her days with her mini Australian Shepherds, potbelly pig, and bearded lizards.

#### Alison MacNeill — Pianist

Alison is a graduate of the University of Guelph and holds an Associate Diploma in Performance from the Royal Conservatory of Music, Toronto. After graduate work at the University of Western Ontario, studying with Ronald Turini, she returned to her home town of Guelph, where she maintains a busy teaching studio. #### Laura Thomas, Artistic Director

WomEnchant's Artistic Director, Laura Thomas, is a conductor, arranger, composer, percussionist and teacher. In addition to her position with WomEnchant, she is also Music Director of the Dundas Valley Orchestra, Associate Conductor of the Niagara Symphony Orchestra and Music Director of the Niagara Youth Orchestra. She was, for six years, Artistic Director of Niagara's Choralis Camerata. She has appeared as a guest conductor with many ensembles including the Huronia Symphony, the Etobicoke Philharmonic and the North York Concert Orchestra.

Ms. Thomas holds a master's degree in conducting from New York's prestigious Bard College, where she studied with Harold Farberman. She is also a graduate of Hamilton's Mohawk College and McMaster University, where she studied percussion and composition. Since 1985, she has been the Principal Percussionist with the Niagara Symphony Orchestra. As well, she is a member of Niagara's popular eclectic folk quintet BroadBand and performs regularly with her Vintage Jazz ensembles.

In her work with WomEnchant and BroadBand, Ms. Thomas has found the opportunity to combine music and activism. Both ensembles perform for a wide variety of social justice events and causes and have raised thousands of dollars through benefit concerts.

#### Tannis Beamer, WomEnchant Accompanist

Tannis Beamer attended the University of Guelph where she majored in Applied Human Nutrition as well as completing a minor in music. She has also completed her Grade 10 Piano through the Royal Conservatory of Music and has taught private piano lessons in the Niagara Region for over 10 years. She runs a thriving studio of 35 students and composes solo works for piano.

Tannis found that her love of music drove her to explore the connection between health and music which resulted in her completing over 60 hours in training as a Soundwork Practitioner with Gary Diggins (Director of the Canadian Association of Sound Practitioners).

This is Tannis' third year as accompanist with WomEnchant Chorus and her second year with WomEnchant Drummers.




