January—We will begin issuing a regular Newsletter telling about new developments at SPECTRUM.

February—We will roll out a new, much improved website.

March—We will be in a legal position to start seeking charitable status. Once we have charitable status (likely not until 2017), we will be able to issue income-tax receipts for donations.
