The COVID 19 pandemic has required many changes in our world to stem the tide of infections and eventually end this outbreak, sadly costing so many lives. Social distancing and self-isolation, while essential for managing this crisis, creates new challenges to our livelihoods, the economy and our physical and mental health. We need to connect and especially in times of high anxiety and fear.

SPECTRUM, due to public health concerns, has had to shutter its doors until public health officials give the all-clear. The duration of this closure is unknown. We recognize services need to be provided in some fashion. After some investigation and testing, the board settled on licensing the Zoom meeting solution.

Zoom was chosen because it provides an easy-to-administer environment, and is simple for participants to access on a variety of platforms. It gives the feeling of a live in-person group meeting within a virtual space.

SPECTRUM will be hosting as many of its regular program meetings on the same evenings as usual. Meetings will be posted on FaceBook (https://www.facebook.com/SpectrumCommunityS-pace/), Twitter (https://twitter.com/our_SPECTRUM) and in the Rainbow Community Calendar giving dates, times, and the required web URL attendees can use to join meetings of interest.

When you click the URL, you will be taken to the Zoom meeting and given instructions on how to join. Arrive a few minutes early so that you can be sure that your device is set up and ready. The browser/app will instruct you on the required steps.
