We are publishing a request for proposal to survey and analyze community requirements. This will be added to a set of requirements already developed by SPECTRUM with the intention of researching and creating a body of knowledge.

This can be used to guide transgender individuals in finding, navigating and securing services within Waterloo Region, as well as, other parts of Canada.

The successful respondent will be required to offer:

- solid understanding of navigating and interacting with various institutional services
- experience with Wordpress, performing/analysing surveys, research and copy-writing, web page creation, email campaigns, social media development, publishing tools
- preference will be given to candidates who identify as transgender or are members of the LGBTQ2S+ community.
