We are excited to inform you that the creation of the TransNAV Directory is well underway!

We've created a survey with a fabulous software called VideoAsk. You can access the survey here. https://www.videoask.com/fb8ui-5jrg Please share the survey with people you know who are on a gender journey. The survey can be completed anonymously and all collected data will be deleted after the project is complete.

Completed surveys will help us di-

rect our efforts – specifically what order our research will be done in and how we categorize elements of the directory. We are researching service providers and professionals in the following categories: Medical, mental health, legal, employment, housing, personal, and social.

The listings will focus on Waterloo Region, though there will be some listings from outside the region for providers such as surgeons and other medical professionals.

The team working on the project is a diverse team and includes members of the trans community.

We hope that you're as excited as we are about the development of this incredible project. The directory is expected to be completed in mid-December and will be available in early 2021. Access to the directory will be available 24/7 on the internet. We will publish the website link as soon as the project is complete!
